The software changes for the IMP release 5.9.0 will become active with the maintenance work during the night of 18.01.2017, unless otherwise stated. The software changes described below do not affect existing interfaces.

General information

- **Elimination of terminal code 081 (Buss Hansa Terminal)**

Please note that the terminal code 081 cannot be used anymore due to the termination of the operation. Preliminary summary declarations, which have already been sent, will expire automatically after 30 days, new manifest data will be rejected from now on.

Information for carriers and terminals

- **Correction of EDIFACT message IFTSTA: Segment FTX+TRA++ANK**

The description of the status message IFTSTA, version 2.2 provides that that the BGM reference of the carrier's manifest shall be transmitted within segment FTX+TRA++ANK+4711BGMREF'. Currently the segment is not included in various status messages. This gap is now to be filled in the course of the release 5.9.0, scheduled on 18.01.2017. Please check, if you can process the segment within the incoming messages.

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Information for freight forwarders

▪ **Announcement: Transmission of ETA in status 900 (Manifest match)**

Currently you receive the ETA via the IMP Status message in XML format solely for status 910 (Line secure), 911 (Delay) and 912 (Early arrival). With the release 6.0.0 the ETA will also be included for status 900 (manifest match) and is expected to be available in production operation as of 15.02.2017.

The ETA will be transmitted as shown in the following example:
