

ZAPP Circular no. 37

Content:

1. Deactivation of declaration case "AEM"
2. New validation for declaration case "EUB"

The ZAPP Circular no. 37 provides information about changes concerning the ZAPP application, developed and agreed by the ZAPP working group (ZAPP AG) respectively resulting of current customs requirements.

1. Deactivation of declaration case "AEM"

The declaration case „AEM“ as AES process for market regulation goods is being deactivated from the ZAPP system, because so-called market regulation goods are no longer existing.

The deactivation is scheduled for the calendar week 28.

2. New validation for declaration case "EUB"

The declaration case „EUB“ may only be used for loadings/shipments of union goods, for on-carriage transport from Hamburg to another EU port.

Therefore, the „country of dispatch/export“ will be validated against the list of EU countries in the future.

The declaration case „EUB“ may not be used in case of shipments which are in temporary storage, after the (land or seaside) presentation of the goods at the customs office Hamburg, and are to be transferred to another EU port.

The declaration case „EUB“ may be used in case of shipments for which an import customs clearance has been carried out in the EU and whose status changed from non-union to union goods. The respective EU country has to be declared as „country of dispatch/export“.

Great Britain applies as EU country in accordance with the above-mentioned regulation until the withdrawal from the customs union has been accomplished (expected by the end of the year 2020).

The activation for the validation is scheduled for the calendar week 28.
